Prayer focus on: Pakistan

Please pray for a gospel outreach being conducted by mission workers amongst the Jogi Hindu minorities in Pakistan. They have also been educating 80 children among this people group across three villages. The children's education has served as an effective bridge to reach this untouched and unreached community. The Jogis are a landless, marginalised and deprived people living under an oppressive regime.

Praise the Lord that these children have the wonderful opportunity to receive an education for the first time in three generations. This work has opened the doors for the Jogi community to hear the gospel. Many are receptive to the gospel and have come to faith in spite of exploitation and mistreatment by their landowners and majority people groups.

Please pray for these new believers, that they would grow in the grace and knowledge of Jesus as their Lord and Saviour; and pray that more Jogi people would respond to the gospel with faith in Christ.
