Prayer: Eritrea, North-East Africa

Thank God that the Eritrean government has released 69 Christian prisoners, many of whom have been in long-term detention for their faith. This follows on from a release of more than 20 male and female prisoners in early September. Barnabas Fund reports that the authorities are continuing to make releases, which are linked to Covid-19 policies, on condition that bail securities are lodged, with guarantors held liable for the detainees' future actions.



According to Eritrean Christian leader Dr Berhane Asmelash, hopes are rising for further significant releases from among the 300 or more

Christians, including adults and children, who remain incarcerated in the military jail, which is notorious for subjecting detainees to solitary confinement in metal shipping containers. While welcoming the news, he noted that no pastors or other senior Christian leaders known to be in captivity were among those released, and he urged for prayer for their safety and release.

Dr Berhane also called for prayer for the released prisoners. "Many have been in prison for a long time.....and will be homeless with nowhere to go. There is no state help in Eritrea.....They need to rehabilitate. We need to pray that they will recover from their trauma.
